It's first come first served to register and display in the art tent next to Redfish Lodge. We have a maximum of 20 display spaces, and you can share a space with another artist if you like.

Accommodations at the Lodge and Cabins are limited, so make your reservations early! We currently have 18 beds reserved.

Camp sites are available near and around the lake, so make your reservations through the U.S. Forest Service ASAP!

Participant Information:

Redfish Lake Lodge; The Redfish Lake Lodge is located on the Northern shore of Redfish Lake. Four nights lodging for Participants is \$250. per bed, pricing may be adjusted based on overall attendance. PAPI has reserved 18 beds, some of which are in shared rooms. Spouses are welcome for an additional fee, but must be registered by the **June 30th deadline**. There will be a 10% cancellation fee. Campgrounds:

There are several camp sites near and around Redfish Lake. If you want to camp in a tent or RV, you must arrange and pay for that on your own, through the US Forest Service (Sawtooth Campgrounds). Find out more at: www.recreation.gov

If you wish to stay beyond the September 8th end of the official PAPI paint out you can extend your stay in Stanley at the Mountain Village Resort. They have hotel rooms or RV campsites.

Sales of Artwork at the Paint Out:

There will be about 20, 10 x 10 spaces available in the large tent adjacent to the lodge. Display spaces will be assigned based on your paid registration for the paint out, so the sooner you register the sooner your display space will be reserved. The paintings in the big tent have sold well at past shows so you don't want to miss this opportunity! A 10% commission will be charged by PAPI to cover the costs of providing someone to sell artwork in the tent during the event. Artists will be responsible for collecting and paying their own sales tax.
